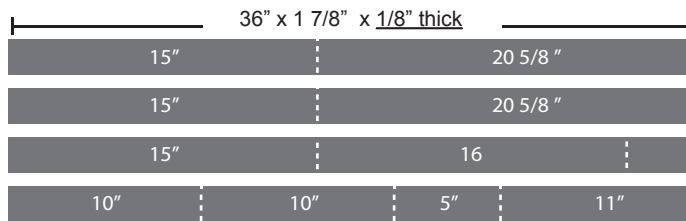
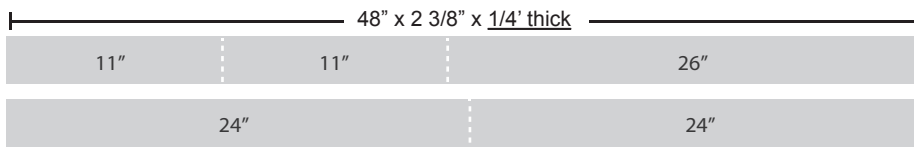
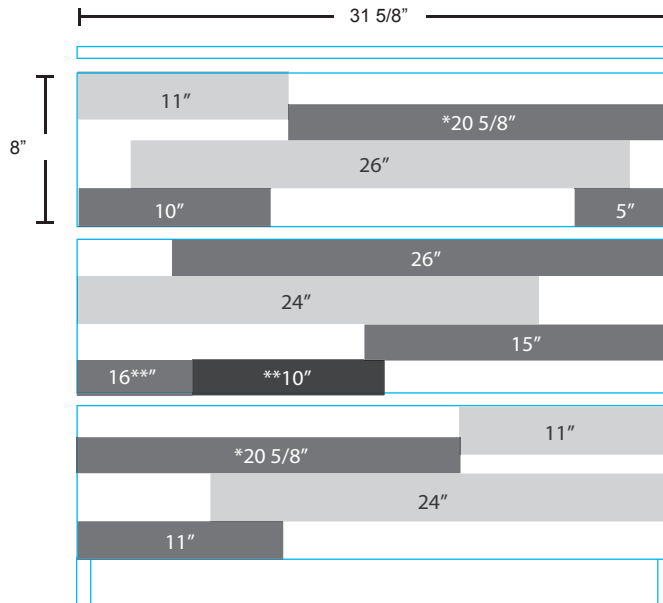


THE MALM MAKEOVER

Materials



Layout



I started out with 2 different thicknesses of strips (1/4" and 1/8"). The strips I found came in either 48" or 36" lengths. The important thing is having different thicknesses of strips so there is a differentiation in depth where they meet.

Here is my layout for the drawers based on the strips that were available to me. I did it so each drawer was filled by four "levels" of strips.

A FEW TIPS:

- Most of the time, you want the strips to butt up to one of the sides on each "level."
- The top and bottom drawers are very similar. To make the four 'levels' of strips span from top to bottom of the drawer, start from the bottom level and work up.
- The middle drawer - this drawer is set up so the pieces fill the vertical space exactly (though I don't think it's the end of the world if things protrude a bit past the bottom). The fourth "level" on this drawer is actually made of two layers of the 1/8" thick strips (**16" with **10" on top, justified right) so that there is a depth difference (which you want) where the 15" and the 16" strip meet.
